BRIEF NOTE ON BASIC TRAINING OF RECRUIT CONSTABLE (DRIVER) OF DELHI POLICE

1. Introduction :-

This institute provides basic training to new recruited constable M/F (Exe.) of Delhi Police who has to be professionally competent and to work as a good policeman in Delhi Police dealing with different aspect of policing as per legal aspects. Training is a conscious effort to impart, improve & increase knowledge and skills and to develop attitudes and values of an individual in a desired direction. It is a process of developing a person's effectiveness through carefully selected teaching methods by competent trainers in suitable learning atmosphere. Training is directed towards preparing an individual for taking greater responsibility. The training involve good driving skills,. There are also trained about motor vehicle act/rules, traffic signages, road discipline and other vehicle and traffic norms.

2. Duration of the training/Course is 09 months with one month commando course.

3. (a) INDOOR TRAINING:

An Asstt. Commissioner of Police (Training) is appointed to supervise the training and assisted by, There are total twelve indoor papers of total 925 marks. The indoor classes run from 10 AM to 3.30 PM with one hour Lunch break.

4 ATTENDANCE:

90% attendenance is compulsory to appear in final exam. However there is provision for 5%+ 5% relaxation in case of genuine reason of shortage of attendance.

5. FINAL EXAMINATIONS :-

Mid term and final exams are conducted for INDOOR & OUTDOOR subjects after the completion of 4 months and 9 months respectively 50% minimum marks are compulsory to qualify in each paper/subjects.

6. ATTESTATION PARADE:-

An attestation-cum-passing out parade, which will include an "oath-taking ceremony", shall be held before the trainees attain the rank of Constable M/F (Exe.). Those who do not qualify in the Indoor and Outdoor examination will not be allowed to participate in the attestation cum passing out parade or take any oath. If they qualify in the two additional chances given, they will be administered oath and allowed to pass out of the PTC. No passing out parade would obviously be held for such individuals.

7. WOMEN TRAINEES:

The women trainees will not incapacitate themselves on account of pregnancy during the training. Women trainees who are pregnant will not be allowed to join training.

8. APPEALS:

A representation with regard to the results will be entertained only within 30 days of declaration of the results.

9. RELAXATION:

The Commissioner of Police may relax any of the conditions laid down for training.

10. DISCIPLINE

During the period of training the trainees shall be deemed to be under the administrative control of Principal for all intent and purposes.
